Perche Creek has been witness to the development of Boone County since the Corps of Discovery passed its entry into the Missouri River on June 6, 1804.

Captain Clark interpreted the French boatmen's name for the high, craggy cliff's split rock which marked the mouth of the creek as Roche Percee, which has evolved into Perche, (pronounced PUR-shi) over the years.

The creek has been traced to its origin in southern Randolph County, and winds its way nearly the full length of Boone County to the Missouri River downstream from McBaine.

Current popularity for the stream comes from the internationally renowned Perche Creek Yacht Club, founded in 1989 at the Little General Store. By its 15th anniversary in 2004, the Club had 576 members in 36 states and 12 foreign countries. Members meet each morning in the Perche Creek Cafe to further its mission of having no purpose.



The former store was demolished in 1995 and replaced with the current facility at which time the Perche Creek Cafe was created. We hope you enjoy your visit with us and will return often.
